Since 2004 we have helped 82 students who are without their mothers realize their dream of going to college. Each student receives a \$4,000 scholarship (distributed in annual distributions of \$1,000) and life coaching support and grief counseling. The year-long coaching and counseling during their senior year of high school include sessions on How to Choose a College, How to Choose a Major, Conflict Resolution, Decision Making, Financial Aid and most importantly How to Cope with Loss as they deal with trying to move on without the love, support and guidance of their mother.
