EXECUTIVE SUMMARY OF EVALUATION FINDINGS

Program Overview

Students Without Mothers, Inc. partnered with PC Eval Consulting, LLC to conduct an independent evaluation of its 2025–2026 College Readiness Program. The evaluation measured changes in students' knowledge, skills, and readiness for college through pre- and post-program surveys. 🎓



Key Findings

Participation contributed to increased knowledge and skills supporting college planning and successful transition beyond high school. Greatest gains were seen in choosing a college, choosing a major, financial aid, college admissions, transition to college, critical thinking & self-sabotage, peer pressure, and financial literacy.



IMPACT HIGHLIGHTS

- 83% INCREASE IN KNOWLEDGE OF REQUIRED COLLEGE APPLICATION FORMS.
- 38% INCREASE IN STUDENTS KNOWING WHERE THEY WANT TO ATTEND COLLEGE.
- 9% INCREASE IN STUDENTS KNOWING THEIR INTENDED COLLEGE MAJOR.
- 55% INCREASE IN STUDENTS REPORTING THEY RARELY PROCRASTINATE.
- 46% INCREASE IN UNDERSTANDING RESPONSIBLE CREDIT USE.
- 32% DECREASE IN REPORTED PEER PRESSURE.
- 46% DECREASE IN SPENDING DUE TO PEER INFLUENCE.
